Lee Eric Williams, owner, said he was granted a 120-day extension in May. There are 24 units that require connection, which he estimated would cost roughly \$75,000 to connect. He stated he had a promissory note due to him on July 1, 2010 "on the other side of \$400,000," which is why he had requested the extension. He did not receive the promissory note as scheduled, and the individual responsible for the note has requested a year's extension.

He stated that he can connect two of the five properties, which are on lift stations, in 45 days. The other three properties can be connected "as I do work." Mr. Williams said the responsibility for the connections became "insurmountable."

Inspector Steyn said the City is sympathetic to Mr. Williams' financial issues, but felt they have been very accommodating by providing extensions in the past. She requested imposition of the accruing fines for all five violations, and asked that these fines continue to accrue.

Mr. Williams said it was not possible to connect all the properties due to economic conditions.

Judge Hull asked how many times Mr. Williams had appeared before him with the same information. Mr. Williams said he had been before the Judge several times, and asserted that "every hearing... I came here with the intentions of hooking these things up." He stated the five buildings are the last five properties that require connection.

Judge Hull imposed fines on all five properties.




