

## **NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, **September 8, 2010** in the Office of the City Engineer, Public Works Department (Engineering and Architectural Services), City Hall, 100 North Andrews Avenue, 4th Floor, City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida and opened immediately thereafter in the Conference Room, for **PROJECT 11183 "BILL KEITH PRESERVE"**

This project consists of Drawing File No. 4-134-11 consisting of twelve (12) sheets, plus cover.

The work includes the following: Furnish all labor, materials and equipment to construct park improvements including, but not limited to site work, clearing and grubbing, grading, concrete paverblock parking lot, miscellaneous concrete foundations, slabs and walks, laminated wood pavilion with cedar shake roofing, signage, raised recycled plastic lumber decking system with integral benches, domestic water supply, drinking fountain, nature trails with timber log edging, solar powered site lighting, site furnishings, irrigation and landscaping as fully documented in plans and specifications.

**A pre-bid meeting will be held on the project site (1720 S.W. 17<sup>th</sup> Street) at 8:30 A.M. August 26, 2010. It is not mandatory to attend this meeting.**

**The prospective bidder is notified that this project has special conditions with regard to time constraints and construction in archaeologically sensitive areas. Please review these conditions in the specification prior to bidding.**

Bidding blanks may be obtained at the Office of the City Engineer. Plans and specifications are on file in the Office of the City Engineer, City of Fort Lauderdale at 100 North Andrews Avenue, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, at a **NON-REFUNDABLE cost of \$25.00 (including sales tax per set)**. Only cash or cashier's check made payable to the City of Fort Lauderdale are accepted. Plans and specifications are also available at no cost on a CD diskette.

**ADDENDA AND INTERPRETATIONS** – No interpretations of the meaning of the plans, specifications or other contract documents will be made orally to any bidder. Prospective bidders must request from the Engineer such interpretations in writing. **To be considered, such request must be received by August 30, 2010. Requests submitted after the aforementioned deadline will not be considered, regardless of when the plans were obtained from the Office of the City Engineer.**

It will be the sole responsibility of the bidder to clearly mark bid as such, and ensure that his bid reaches the City prior to the bid opening date and time listed.

A certified check, cashier's check, bank officer's check or bid bond for five percent (5%) of the amount bid, made payable to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, shall accompany each proposal.

The City of Fort Lauderdale reserves the right to waive any informality in any bid and to reject any or all bids.
