



ELECTRICAL APPLICATION FOR 30 DAY TEMPORARY POWER

This issuance of a 30-day temporary power permit is governed by the conditions of the Florida Building Code. The usage of the electrical power is for building construction operations and testing purposes only.

This permit is for a period of thirty (30) days and must be renewed if a Certificate of Occupancy is not completed in this time period. Temporary power will only be granted for two 30-day periods unless there are special conditions. These special conditions must be outlined in a letter to the Chief Electrical Inspector and indicate the projected date of the Certificate of Occupancy. This letter must be approved by the Chief Electrical Inspector before the first 30-day applications is submitted.

This 30-day temporary power permit is being issued for the property listed below only.
