YOUTH ENRICHMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Youth Enrichment Scholarship (Y.E.S.) is available to City residents. Applicants must bring proof that the child is currently on the School Board's free or reduced lunch program and proof of City residency.

BEACH INFORMATION

FORT LAUDERDALE BEACH

Fort Lauderdale Beach is one of the world's premier beachfronts boasting more than seven miles of sparkling beaches that offer residents and visitors opportunities for recreation, relaxation and enjoyment. The City's award-winning wavewall and signature beachfront promenade highlight Fort Lauderdale's world famous coastline. Beachgoers can participate in a wide range of recreational activities or, if relaxation is what you desire, simply sit back, unwind and enjoy breathtaking views of the Atlantic Ocean.

Fort Lauderdale Ocean Rescue supervises three miles of continuous public beach from Fort Lauderdale Beach Park to N.E. 18th Street. In the guarded areas of the beach, there are 20 year-round, permanently staffed lifeguard towers spaced between 200 and 400 yards apart. The lifeguard towers are staffed daily from 9:45 a.m. to 5 p.m.

For your safety, surf advisory flags are posted at each Ocean Rescue Lifeguard tower. Please remember that ocean conditions can change quickly and you should always swim near a lifeguard. If you are uncertain about surf conditions or have any questions, please ask a lifeguard.

CANINE BEACH

The City of Fort Lauderdale has set aside a section of Fort Lauderdale Beach where you and your pooch can enjoy the beach and ocean. Canine Beach begins at the intersection of Sunrise Boulevard and A1A and extends north 100 yards on the beach. Please see the park ranger on duty for extra pooper-scoopers, if needed.

Days: Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays only

Winter Hours: 3:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Summer Hours: 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. (during Daylight Savings Time)

Annual Permit Fee (January 1 to December 31):

Residents - \$30 per dog

Non-Residents - \$45 per dog

Lost Permit Replacement - \$5

Annual permits must be purchased in-person at the City of Fort Lauderdale Parks and Recreation Administration, 1350 W. Broward Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale 33312 (Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.). Annual renewals may be handled by mail.

One-Weekend Permit - \$7 per dog

Canine Beach Rules

1. Dogs shall be on a leash at all times.
2. A person walking with a dog must be in possession of a device to properly dispose of any fecal matter deposited by their dog.
3. Dogs shall not create a nuisance by causing any form of disturbance such as excessive barking and/or similar undesirable conduct.
4. The permit holder must carry permit with them at all times when using Canine Beach.

PARK INFORMATION - DOGS

DOG WALKING ON A1A

Dog walking is allowed on the west side of A1A from Sunrise Boulevard south to the southernmost intersection of A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard. Note: You may walk dogs on the west side of A1A, north of Sunrise Boulevard, 24 hours a day (no permit required).

Days: 365 days a year

Hours: 6:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.

Fee: Included with purchase of annual Canine Beach permit (see page 4).

DOG WALKING ON A1A RULES

1. Dogs shall be on a leash at all times.
2. A person walking with a dog must be in possession of a device to properly dispose of any fecal matter deposited by their dog.
3. Dogs shall not create a nuisance by causing any form of disturbance such as excessive barking and/or similar undesirable conduct.
4. The permit holder must carry permit with them at all times when walking dogs on A1A between Sunrise Boulevard to the southernmost intersection of A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard.

RIVERWALK LINEAR PARK

Dogs are allowed in Riverwalk Linear Park, which is located along the New River in downtown Fort Lauderdale at 20 N. New River Drive from S.W. 5th Avenue to S.E. 2nd Avenue. Note: Pooper-scoopers are available in boxes along the Riverwalk.

Hours: 24 hours a day

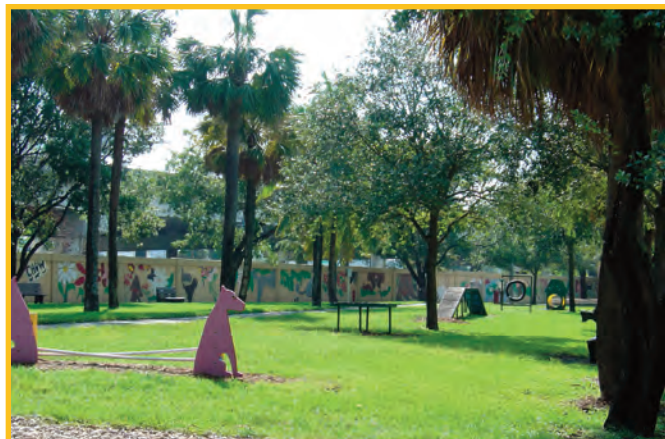

PARK INFORMATION - DOGS

BARK PARK AT SNYDER PARK

Bark Park is a great place to walk your dog and meet friends! Located within the traditional setting of Fort Lauderdale's beautiful Snyder Park, Bark Park provides a wonderful opportunity for your dog to play off-leash and for owners and dogs to relax and socialize. Features include fully-fenced, small/large dog areas, shelters, two levels of drinking fountains for dogs, benches and agility equipment, two hose stations, pooper-scooper supply depot and disposal bins. Snyder Park is located at 3299 S.W. 4th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33315. For more information on Bark Park at Snyder Park, please call (954) 828-4341.



Days: Open 363 days per year (closed Christmas Day and New Year's Day)

Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. (closed Thursdays from 8:00 – 11:00 a.m. for cleaning)

Fees: Free

Parking Fees: Only on weekends and holidays -\$1 per hour, \$5 daily maximum

Bark Park Rules

1. All dogs must have current rabies shot. Puppies under four (4) months old are not allowed in the park.
2. Dogs must be on a leash in the parking lot, and on the way in and out of the park. Owners must carry a leash while in Bark Park. No spiked or pinch collars.
3. Owners must remain in Bark Park with dog, clean up after their dog, and monitor the dog's behavior.
4. If your dog becomes aggressive, it must be removed from the park immediately.
5. No more than three (3) dogs per person are permitted in Bark Park.
6. Rollerblading, roller-skating, and bike riding are not permitted in Bark Park.
7. Dogs in heat, ill and/or with internal or external parasites (fleas, ticks, or worms) are not allowed in the park.
8. Please keep the park gates closed at all times.
9. If your dog digs, it must be stopped and you are responsible for filling in the hole.
10. All children under the age of 13 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
11. No human food allowed in the park. Treats to be used for training purposes only. Please feed your dog only

Swimming for dogs is available at Snyder Park's East Lake.

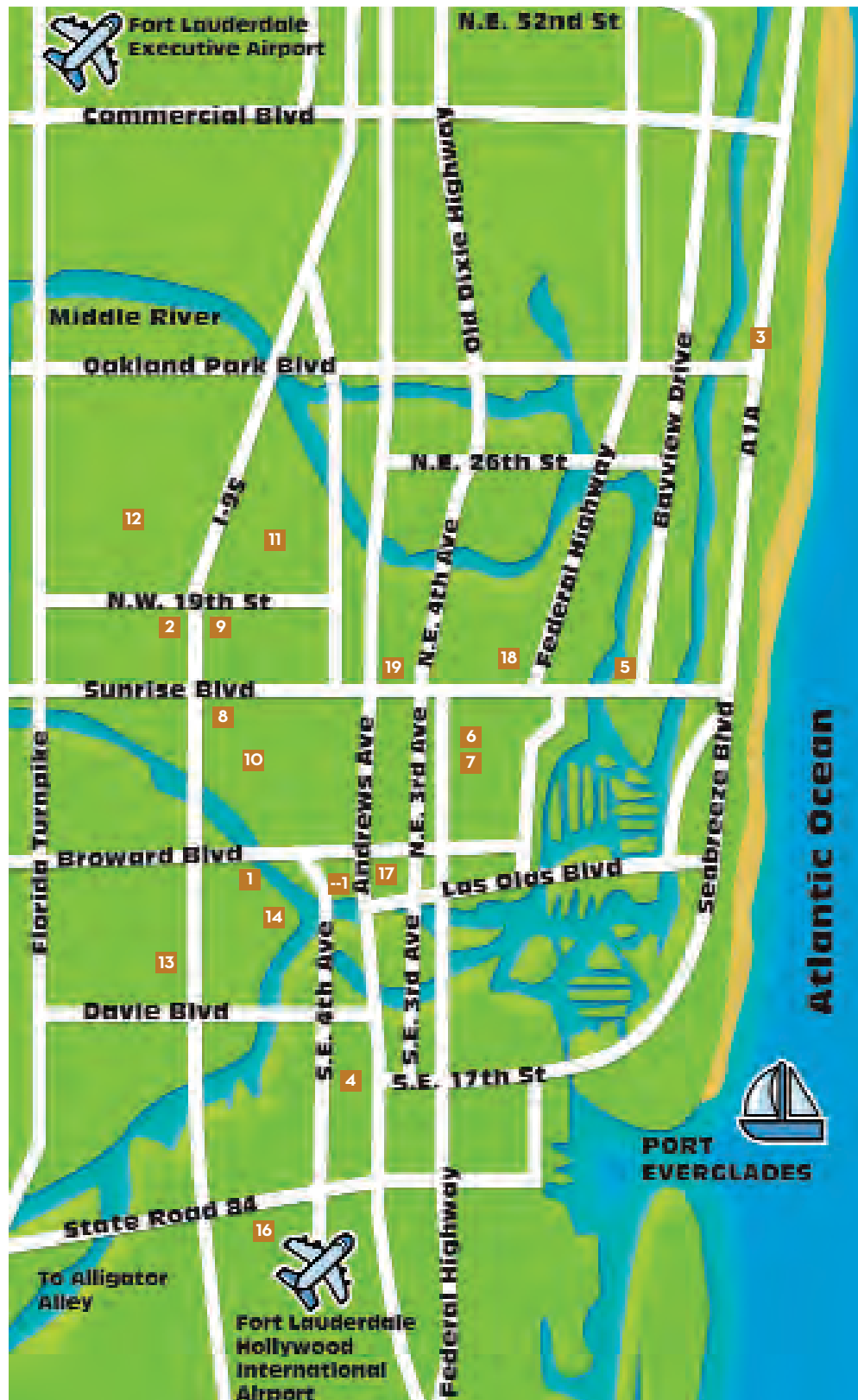
Days: Every day except on Christmas Day, New Year's Day and when East Lake is closed for routine treatment the first Tuesday and Wednesday of each month.

Alcohol, gas grills and amplified music are not allowed in the parks. Soliciting and homeless feeding programs are not allowed. Attendance is limited to 50 people and your rental does not provide exclusive use of the park. No tents or canopies may be used. Sidewalks may not be blocked with chairs.

ADA Event Coordinator

The City of Fort Lauderdale has a designated ADA event coordinator who has knowledge of all accessibility features of City park facilities and events. The ADA event coordinator can provide the public with information regarding the accessibility of upcoming events, including the location of disabled parking, location of accessible restrooms and amenities, and the location of special features to assist disabled persons.

The ADA event coordinator can also address the needs and requests of persons with disabilities, including requests for reasonable accommodations to participate in City events.
