BACKGROUND:

THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE HAS RECENTLY BEEN AWARDED A CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT (CLG) GRANT FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO DEVELOP DESIGN GUIDELINES FOR THE CITY'S HISTORIC ARCHITECTURAL RESOURCES.

AS PART OF THIS EFFORT, THE CITY HIRED THE FIRM PRESERVATION DESIGN PARTNERSHIP, INC. (PDP) TO SERVE AS THE PROJECT CONSULTANT AND WORK WITH THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD (HPB), INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS, AND CITY STAFF OVER THE COURSE OF THE NEXT NINE (9) MONTHS TO COMPLETE THIS PROJECT.

This kickoff meeting is critical in the process because it will establish:

1. The general framework for the project;
2. The overall approach, format and document organization;
3. Developing a review and confirmation of the proposed work plan.

Three (3) additional public workshops will be scheduled throughout the course of this project to disseminate draft documents and obtain public comment.
