Free Sun Trolley Service, provided courtesy of the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association, will be available as follows:

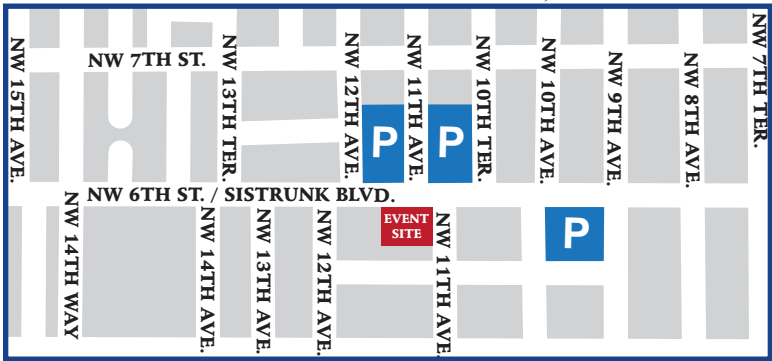
10:00 a.m. - from NW 11th Avenue and
