THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this ____ day of ____, 2010, is by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipality, ("City"), whose address is 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301-1016, and Contenders Boxing, LLC, a Florida Limited Liability Company ("Contractor"), whose address and phone are 3230 Jackson Blvd, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33312, Phone 954-274-2699, Fax: 954-985-9505.

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Proposal 505-10555 ("RFP"), and the Contractor submitted a bid in response to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale approved an agreement with Contractor for the goods or services described in the RFP (Pur-02, CAR No. 10-1389),

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to provide to the City Boxing Instruction Services in accordance with and in strict compliance with the specifications, terms, conditions, and requirements set forth in the RFP and any and all addenda thereto beginning October 15, 2010 and ending October 14, 2011.

2. This contract form G-110 Rev. 01/10, the RFP, any and all addenda to the RFP, and the Contractor's proposal in response to the RFP are integral parts of this Contract, and are incorporated herein.

3. In the event of conflict between or among the contract documents, the order of priority shall be as follows:

- First, this contract form, G-110 Rev. 01/10;
- Second, any and all addenda to the City's RFP in reverse chronological order;
- Third, the RFP;
- Fourth, the Contractor's response to any addendum requiring a response;
- Fifth, the Contractor's response to the RFP.

4. The Company warrants that the goods and services supplied to the City pursuant to this Contract shall at all times fully conform to the specifications set forth in the RFP and be of the highest quality. In the event the City, in the City's sole discretion, determines that any product or service supplied pursuant to this Contract is defective or does not conform to the specifications set forth in the RFP the City reserves the right unilaterally to cancel an order or cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor, and reduce commensurately any amount of money due the Contractor.

5. The City may cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor in the event the Contractor fails to furnish the goods or perform the services as described in the RFP within 30 days following written notice to the Contractor.

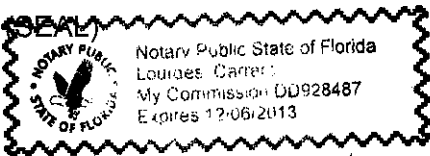

Tab 1: Understanding of the City's needs for recreational and competitive amateur boxing skill training and your overall approach to those needs.

Response: It is my understanding that the city of Fort Lauderdale has had a boxing program. I have been running this program for the past 10 years. This program has helped young men developed skills and self-confidence to achieve more in school as well as in life. Not every boxer that comes through our program aspires to be a professional boxer but we would train them to be productive adults.

Tab 2: Approach and concept for the provision of boxing training.

Response: We as trainers will work one on one with the young men on boxing skills and conditioning training. We physically prepare them with a series of skills such as sparing, shadow boxing, jump rope, hitting of different types of heavy bags, and running for example. We train them mentally by talking strategy and preparing them for competition in the form of encouragement, etc.

Tab 3: Credentials, References, Professional Affiliations and Certifications for Contractor and all their employees to be used in service. Employment history of all coaches.

Response: I have been a USA Boxing coach for 25 years. I have been a certified referee for 3 ½ years. I am also affiliated with USA Boxing Amateur Federation for the past 30 years and am currently employed with the Broward Sheriff's Office for the past 25 years.

Tab 4: Types of equipment, teaching aides the contractor provides. Any equipment, teaching aides expected to be provided by City. Type of safety equipment the contractor provides.

Response: Boxing ring, heavy bags, speed bags, double-end bags, gloves, head gear, hand wraps, mouthpieces, and all equipment associated with boxing. There is no equipment that needs to be provided by the City. Safety equipment includes head gear, protected cup, mouthpiece, and hand wraps.

Tab 5: Number of students instructed/trained in the past year.

Response: 100+

Tab 6: Number of classes and levels of classes instructed in the past year.

Response: Classes – 5 days per week which equals approximately 240 classes a year.

Tab 7: Detailed lesson progressions of training to be offered.

Response: Four rounds of shadow boxing, four rounds of heavy bags, three rounds of speed bag, three rounds of double-end bag, four rounds of mitts, three rounds of jump rope, and calisthenics involving running, sit-ups, push-ups, pull-ups, etc.

Tab 8: Student/Coach Ratio; Ages of participants.

Response: 5 to 1 ratio; 9 years of age and up. We provide boxing skills to everyone. No one is turned away.

Tab 9: Program fees.

Response: Fee - \$0. We do ask a \$70 membership fee for USA Boxing which covers insurance for the boxers.

Tab 10: Contractor should provide a floor plan for boxing room indicating layout of equipment.

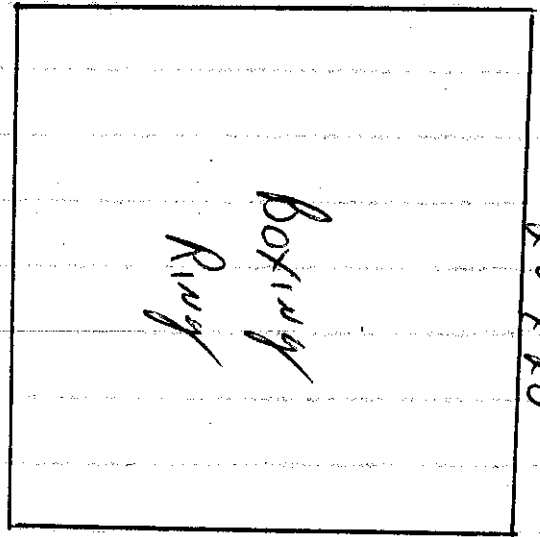
