Both certificates are included. LES is neither a parent nor a subsidiary to any other company. LES provides DMV registration information to municipalities, public universities, and tollways throughout the United States from its headquarters in Long Island City, NY.

#### 2.

In September 1999, LES scored a violation industry first when it released *DMVRegInfo*, an Internet service that retrieves vehicle registered-owner information from over 40 state



DMVs, with data procured from more than 30 state DMVs overnight. Agencies that are using *DMVRegInfo* to maximize revenue from violators include: Inglewood, CA, New York City Parking Violations Bureau, NYC Red Light Enforcement Program, the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission and the Illinois State Highway Toll Authority (statewide toll systems), Colorado E-470 Public Highway

and numerous municipalities and state universities. Other major violation processing and collection companies using *DMVRegInfo* on behalf of their clients include: T2 Systems, Cardinal Tracking, Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson LLP, Nestor Traffic Systems, and Drico Recovery Systems. LES currently has 35 employees and 15,000 square feet of office space.

Two employees monitor the sending and receiving of files and assist DMVReg clients. Only authorized users have access to the computer systems via their unique user IDs and passwords. The release of DMV information is strictly governed by the Federal Drivers Privacy Protection Act and is subject to periodic audit by individual States. As such, LES' proprietary DMVRegInfo system automatically tracks all client requests for information and date of fulfillment. A historical audit trail is maintained by LES for all clients and is available as part of a printed report. All LES employees sign an acknowledgment of the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act and a Security Agreement that subjects them to immediate dismissal for any breach of policy and procedures.
