THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 4th day of May, 2010, is by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipality, ("City"), whose address is 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301-1016, and Paddles and Boards, Inc., a Florida corporation ("Contractor"), whose address and phone are 1900 Van Buren Street, Suite 105B, Hollywood, FL 33020, Phone: 954-648-3473, Fax: 800-613-2166.

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Proposal 505-10395 ("RFP"), and the Contractor submitted a bid in response to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale approved an agreement with Contractor for the goods or services described in the RFP (Pur-01, CAR No. 10-0463),

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to provide to the City Paddleboard Activity Services Concession in accordance with and in strict compliance with the specifications, terms, conditions, and requirements set forth in the ITB and any and all addenda thereto beginning May 4, 2010 and ending May 3, 2013.

2. This contract form G-110 Rev. 01/10, the RFP, any and all addenda to the RFP, and the Contractor's proposal in response to the RFP are integral parts of this Contract, and are incorporated herein.

3. In the event of conflict between or among the contract documents, the order of priority shall be as follows:

First, this contract form, G-110 Rev. 01/10;

Second, any and all addenda to the City's RFP in reverse chronological order;

Third, the RFP;

Fourth, the Contractor's response to any addendum requiring a response;

Fifth, the Contractor's response to the RFP

4. The Contractor warrants that the goods and services supplied to the City pursuant to this Contract shall at all times fully conform to the specifications set forth in the RFP and be of the highest quality. In the event the City, in the City's sole discretion, determines that any product or service supplied pursuant to this Contract is defective or does not conform to the specifications set forth in the RFP the City reserves the right unilaterally to cancel an order or cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor, and reduce commensurately any amount of money due the Contractor.

5. The City may cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor in the event the Contractor fails to furnish the goods or perform the services as described in the RFP within 30 days following written notice to the Contractor.

6. The Contractor shall not present any invoice to the City that includes sales tax (85-8012514506C-7) or federal excise tax (59-6000319).

7. Contractor shall pay to the City a fixed monthly concession fee, in advance, based on that amount submitted in the proposal. The initial monthly payment shall be paid by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

- 8. Additional Special Conditions: Concession shall prohibit anyone under the age of 18 from renting or otherwise using their equipment without written consent from parents.







## **SAFETY PROCEDURES**

Paddles and Boards Inc. shall conduct its operation in accordance with all laws, rules, and regulations relating to the safe operation of the concession.

Release of liability forms approved by the city shall be kept on file for the City to review as requested or in the case of an accident/injury. A copy of the waiver and release of liability shall be included as part of this plan

The City reserves the right to issue additional beach rules and regulations as deemed necessary by the City. Paddles and Boards agree to abide by any new or revised rules and regulations that the City deems necessary.

Any change or addition to the concessionaires operation will require prior review and approval of all applicable City Departments.

Paddles and Boards shall prohibit anyone under the age of 16 from renting or otherwise using their Equipment without written consent from parents. Paddles and Boards shall pre-screen all renters to determine their ability to operate rental equipment.

Paddles and Boards will provide a complete list of instructions that is signed by the participants verifying that they understand all conditions of operating the equipment.

Paddles and Boards will provide on-the-water demonstration and a check ride to evaluate the proficiency of renters.

Pre-Rental Verbal and Written instruction on the safe operation of equipment will be provided.

These instructions will include, at a minimum, operational characteristics of the equipment, safe operation and right-of-way, operator responsibilities, and local waterway characteristic.



The instruction will include:

### **Personal floatation Devices:**

Paddles and Boards will have available and provide an approved personal floatation device to all renters of equipment. Such device shall be of the type and class approved for such use by the Coast Guard.

It shall be the sole responsibility of Paddles and Boards to insure the renter is capable of properly adjusting and using such a device. Information on the proper use of this equipment will be provided to the user should there be any doubt relating to the renter's ability to properly use this equipment.

Paddles and Boards shall insure that each approved personal floatation device is being worn properly, prior to the operator leaving the beach area. Removal of such equipment during the rental period while equipment is actually in use shall be construed as a violation of the rental agreement.



### **Safety Markers**

Safety markers shall be posted on the sandy beach to delineate the equipment concession recreational area as per City Ordinance. Safety markers shall be at the sole cost and expense of Paddles and Boards.

### **HURRICANE EVACUATION PLAN**

Concessionaire agrees that all its storage, non-motorized watercraft rental equipment and any and all other equipment or other items used in the concession operations will be removed from the beachfront immediately within two (2) hours of notification by appropriate City authorities, and stored at an approved, private, off-site location.


