hereinafter called the "Company" or "Contractor" Witnesseth that: Whereas, the City did advertise and issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for supplying the requirements of the City for the items and/or service listed above, for a period of **two years with two two-year extension options** and the Contractor submitted a bid that was accepted and approved by the City.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Company agrees to provide vehicle towing services in the Northern and Southern Zones of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, during the period beginning 05/15/07 and ending 05/14/09 for the requirements listed above and according to the following specifications, terms, covenants and conditions:

a. This contract form G-110, the Request for Proposal containing General Conditions, Special Conditions, Specifications, addenda, if any, and other attachments forming a part of RFP Number 175-9720 and the Contractor's proposal in response, form a part of this contract and by reference are incorporated herein.

b. In construing the rights and obligations between the parties, the order of priority in cases of conflict between the documents shall be as follows:

- 1) This contract Form G-110, Rev. 12/00
- 2) The City's RFP and all addenda thereto
- 3) Contractor's bid/proposal in response to the City's RFP

c. **Warranty:** The Company by executing this contract embodying the terms herein warrants that the product and/or service that is supplied to the City shall remain fully in accord with the specifications and be of the highest quality. In the event any product and/or service as supplied to the City is found to be defective or does not conform to specifications the City reserves the right to cancel that order upon written notice to the Contractor and to adjust billing accordingly.

d. **Cancellation:** The City may cancel this contract upon notice in writing should the Contractor fail to reasonably perform the service of furnishing the products and/or services as specified herein upon 30 days written notice. This applies to all items of goods or services.

e. **Taxes Exempt:** State Sales (#16-03-196479-54C) and Federal Excise (#59-600319) Taxes are normally exempt, however, certain transactions are taxable. Consult your tax practitioner for guidance where necessary.

f. **Invoicing:** Contractor will forward all invoices in duplicate for payment to the following: Finance Department, 100 N. Andrews Avenue, 6th Floor, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301. If discount, other than prompt payment terms applies, such discount MUST appear on the invoice.

Two tanker accidents halt rush hour traffic

Turnpike closed for fuel cleanup rescue; Griffin Road blocked

fuel tankers flipped over in the crashes Thursday afternoon, spilling thousands of gallons of gasoline down Florida's Turnpike and two Interstate 95 lanes during rush hour. The trouble started about 1:50 p.m. just south of Sample Road in Pompano Beach. Tanker driver Jerison, 44, of Plantation, tried

Florida Highway Patrol. The 9,000-gallon tanker fishtailed, jackknifed and toppled over into the grassy median, spilling half of its load.

Rescuers waded knee-deep in gasoline to rescue Nixon and offload the remaining fuel, said Sandra King, spokeswoman for the city.

Firefighters with Pompano Beach Fire-Rescue couldn't use their usual extraction tools to rescue the trapped driver for fear a spark could ignite 1,500 gallons of

Rescuers finally pulled the driver out of the crippled cab 30 minutes later and rushed him to North Broward Medical Center, King said. The man's injuries were not life-threatening, she said. His identity was not released Thursday.

Nearly five hours after the Pompano Beach crash, another tanker overturned in Dania Beach creating more rush hour mayhem. Griffin Road was closed in both directions at Interstate 95 and all ramps to the highway were blocked.

About 6:15 p.m., a 3,000-gallon truck was entering I-95 northbound at Griffin Road when it hit a curb and flipped, said Jim Lejedal, a Broward Sheriff's Office spokesman.


The turnpike spill shut down the

kept northbound closed for more than five more hours as firefighters hosed the gasoline down with a protective foam and offloaded the remaining fuel into another tanker. Reyes said Nixon will be given a citation for failure to use due care.

Access to and from I-95 at Griffin Road was blocked through the evening in Dania Beach, Broward County and Sunrise firefighters cleaned up the spill. Officials expected the lanes to reopen in the early morning hours today. Traffic was further snarled Thursday by a crash near Stirling Road on I-95 northbound.

A woman driving on Interstate 595 was killed on Wednesday after a tractor-trailer hauling construction debris and tree stumps turned over, dumping its load on drivers below.

Large chunks of debris rained from Interstate 595, killing one person and hitting other cars, after a tractor-trailer toppled on its side Wednesday afternoon on a highway overpass, officials said.

The driver of the truck lost control on a westbound ramp leading to Florida's Turnpike from I-595, and the contents of the trailer he was hauling dropped onto the eastbound lanes of I-595, according to Lt. Roger Reyes, a spokesman for the Florida Highway Patrol.

Jennifer Green, 49, of Margate was killed when debris fell from the bridge, smashing through the windshield of her green Dodge Caravan, Reyes said.

Her daughter, Latoya Green, 18, held a picture of her mother from

last Christmas.

"She's not going to be here for this Christmas," she said.

Green's husband, Lascelles Green, described his wife as a church leader who worked with youth at Royal Palm Seventh-day Adventist Church in Fort Lauderdale.

"It's a big loss, I would say, for the world," Green told Herald news partner WFOR CBS-4.

At the time of the crash, Jennifer Green was on her way to the airport to pick up a relative who was flying in from Jamaica, family




members said.

"Everyone asks why," her nephew, Lamar Bernard, said to CBS-4.

"Maybe it's an example for us all. Don't regret what you have. You have a family friend who can be gone just like this."

Earlier this year, four people were killed in a fiery wreck at a different point in the same interchange. The driver of a tanker, loaded with 9,000 gallons of fuel, lost control as he exited I-595 onto

All drivers are trained and skilled in the effective operation of their wreckers. They are also experienced in evaluating and providing the services necessary for the removal of overturned vehicles, crushed vehicles, and submerged vehicles. All drivers are attired in official company uniforms. They are specially trained to assist and accommodate motorists and passengers who are at the scene of any break down or accident as described in our Scope of Service. This includes arranging for WestWay's "ON CALL" Customer Service Vehicle to transport motorists and passengers at the time of an accident or Break down location to their Broward County home or our executive offices, or even to a rental car office. WestWay Towing has Certified Divers available 24 hours a day.

Westway Towing Driver Policy and Procedure Manual

Section One

Driver Requirements: It is your duty as a driver of Westway towing to follow the guidelines set forth by the company, and the laws that govern the towing industry.

Section Two

Ticket Procedures: All tickets must be filled out properly and legible. Each ticket is required to have the following information: Police calls you are required to record the case number. For motor club calls, record the VIN, tag, and mileage numbers. 97, 51, and 98 times must be recorded on every tow ticket.

Section Three

Property Inventory of Towed Vehicles: Every car that is towed in must have all valuable property removed from car. All property must be brought in to dispatch to be labeled and then placed in the property room. Failure to remove property from vehicle can result in automatic termination.

Section Four

Two-way Radios: The proper way to use the two-way radio, when calling dispatch, is to first key up identifying your truck number. Then wait for dispatch to acknowledge you back by your truck number. If you do not receive a response from dispatch within one minute key back up, identifying your truck number again. Keep all conversations on the radio to a bare minimum. Do not call in to dispatch on landline unless you absolutely have to. When you are using a landline, you are tying up valuable customer lines.

Section Five

Truck Assignment: Each driver is issued a specific truck to drive during their shift. It is the driver's responsibility to check the truck out before their shift starts. Each driver is responsible for making sure they have all the equipment that is required to do their job. All trucks must be able to pass an FHP inspection at any given time. It is the driver's responsibility to make sure that truck meets the FHP requirements and has the equipment that is required by FHP. Drivers are responsible for keeping their trucks clean. No driver is allowed to add anything to a Westway Tow Truck without approval.

Section Six

Attendance: All drivers are required to work the shift that they are given. Drivers must report on time and complete their shift. Any driver who is not going to be in for their shift must call in one hour before their shift starts. Any driver wanting a day off or to get off work early, must submit it in writing and it must be approved.

Westway Towing Driver Policy and Procedure Manual

Section Seven

Uniforms: All drivers are issued uniforms by Westway Towing. It is required that you be in full uniform during your shift. Shirts must be buttoned. T-shirts are not allowed in place of the company issued uniform.

Section Eight

Westway Office: Drivers need to stay out of the office unless it is mandatory that they come inside. Tickets need to be turned in at outside window of dispatch. Do not be hanging around in the office.

Section Nine

Westway Shop: Do not be hanging in the shop stopping the mechanic from doing his job. If your truck is being worked on, you are not allowed to be in the shop. If you have a problem with your truck and it does not require immediate attention, you must write the problem down on a piece of paper with your truck number and turn it in with your recap.

Section Ten

Driver Recap: All drivers must complete a driver recap envelope at the end of their shift. Every ticket must be turned in for that day. All money turned in with tickets and the recap dropped.

Section Eleven

Fueling of Trucks: All drivers must fuel their trucks at the end of their shift.

Section Twelve

Emergency Callout: Drivers that drive their tow trucks home need to be aware that they can be called out in an emergency situation. This will only be done in an emergency and the driver needs to be available.

Section Thirteen

Disciplinary Actions: Disciplinary action for not following these guidelines will result in suspension without pay. Repeat offenders will be terminated.

TECHNICAL APPROACH
FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA

Our scope of service is further amplified by applying the following qualifications and service. In addition to providing the basic Towing services, WestWay Towing includes special features that make our plan of service most effective and beneficial to the residents of Fort Lauderdale.

*****SPECIAL FEATURES*****

1. ON-CALL CUSTOMER SERVICE VEHICLE

Free transportation is provided to those in need at the scene of an accident or breakdown. There are times when a family of two or more are traveling in their vehicle possibly to there hockey game, dinner, movie, etc. If their vehicle has been in an accident or breakdown and WestWay Towing is called by the City of Fort Lauderdale, most tow trucks are not capable of transporting two or more family members. WestWay Towing does not allow any residents to be left stranded at a breakdown or accident scene. Fort Lauderdale residents will be taken to their home, local car rental agency, or to our primary office free of charge. WestWay Towing has a 2004 Dodge Magnum station wagon that will be used to perform these services. We would not take a vehicle and leave your residents abandoned. Your officers just need to request this service, and it will be dispatched with the Tow Truck. This will stop your Police Officers from transporting people home, and keep them on the road to do policing.

2. SAFE, ACCESSIBLE LOCATION

All Fort Lauderdale residents can reach our primary location within minutes. Primary needs for your residents can be met at our location. This facility is over 4 acres, and is surrounded by an 8 foot wall. Our offices are in safe walking distances to banking facilities, hotels, restaurants, and a car rental facility. WestWay Towing was built adjacent to home owners, and is not in an industrial park where a lack of security could cause damage to Fort Lauderdale residents vehicles or themselves. Our facility is within 25 feet of home owners who gave us there blessing when we applied for construction. There is an inside waiting area, and bathrooms are available if requested.

3. TRAFFIC HOMICIDE AND CRIME SCENES

WestWay Towing has been approved by the Broward Sheriffs Office, Lauderhill Police Dept., and Sunrise Police Dept., to service potential Traffic Homicide Accidents. Our employees are experienced in recovering and holding vehicles in strict compliance with the needs of onsite traffic investigations and crime scenes. WestWay Towing has worked with these special Police investigators for almost fifteen years, and has developed extensive experience in complex recoveries involving Police, Fire, and Emergency Agencies. WestWay Towing has experience in all types of Towing and Recoveries. At the present time WestWay Towing is handling Traffic Homicide scenes for the Broward Sheriffs Office in West Broward County. WestWay has handled some of the most complex recoveries such as the plane crash on Commercial Blvd. to the tractor-trailer roll-over on Interstate 95, and the loaded gasoline tanker on the Turnpike. WestWay has current agreements with some of the major motor clubs to provide service directly to their members. This will benefit the City of Fort Lauderdale Police Department with a better response time. We also tow for most of the new car warrantee plans, but limit ourselves to Police Towing for the Cities that we service.

5. FORT LAUDERDALE ACCOMODATION FOR QUICK RESPONSE TIME

WestWay Towing will have units placed strategically within the City of Fort Lauderdale boundaries at all times. The adjacent cities that we service has our trucks going through the City of Fort Lauderdale all day which enables a quick response time. If a truck was pulled from this zone we would move another into the appropriate zone. WestWay Towing knows what your residents are going to go through when their vehicle is towed, so we have developed these features to help them get through their dilemma. WestWay Towing prides on taking care of stranded motorists. I own Wreck-a-Mended Collision Center and offer a valuable service to your residents. We help them throughout their complete dilemma. I can offer these services because I have been educated as a claims handler that worked for two major insurance companies. I have settled claims as an adjuster, and know all the procedures to guide your residents in the right path. WestWay Towing has purchased, developed, and has relocated to our new ENVIRONMENTALLY STATE OF THE ART TOWING AND STORAGE FACILITY located at 3681 West Oakland Park Blvd., Lauderdale Lakes, FL 33311. This four acre facility is the largest towing and storage facility west of I- 95 in Central Broward County. Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. WestWay Towing is less than 2.0 miles away from the City of Fort Lauderdale City Limits. The City of Fort Lauderdale Police Dept. has been to our site numerous times to do theft investigations. Being so close to your City; if needed the Police Officer could be available back in the City in minutes. Why loose your officer to a facility up to 10 miles away.
