BACKGROUND/DETAIL:

In February 2009, President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The ARRA is an unprecedented effort by the United States Federal government to jumpstart the US economy, address numerous economic challenges, and create or save millions of jobs.

In April 2009 the City applied to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) via the Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse, for the federally funded 2010 Recovery Act Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant. On September 18, 2009 the grant was awarded in the amount of \$183,508, in support of Operation Crystal Blues. The goal of Operation Crystal Blues is to continue the Police Department's comprehensive strategy aimed at combating the sale, distribution and consumption of methamphetamine and to disseminate information regarding the dangers of these illegal narcotics to high school students in the classroom setting. The awarded grant funds will support overtime salaries and equipment purchases related to the conduct of Operation Crystal Blues.

The grant project period is October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010. The grant does not require a local cash match.

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve acceptance of this grant award in the amount of \$183,508 and authorize the proper City Officials to execute all necessary documents to receive and appropriate these funds.




