## SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION BEGINS APRIL 11

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION - COMMUNITY AND SPORTS & ACTIVITY CAMPS

#### **WHEN can I register?**

Registration begins at 8 a.m. on the dates listed below and will close when the camp is full. Registration is offered on a first come, first served basis. Many of our programs fill quickly, so register early to secure your spot!

**Residents - Registration begins April 11 at 8 a.m.**

**Online Resident Registration - Registration begins April 18.**

**Non-Residents - Registration begins April 25 at 9 a.m.**

#### **WHERE can I register?**

**In-Person** - All camp locations will be accepting registrations for their own camp programs, excluding Camp Riverside. To register for Camp Riverside's program, please do so at Holiday Park Social Center located at 1150 G. Harold Martin Drive.

### ONLINE REGISTRATION IS AVAILABLE!

Beginning **April 18**, Fort Lauderdale residents can register online for our community and sports and activity camps.

You must have an account to access our online registration system. Participants who have previously registered for recreational programs may call (954) 828-5346 to create an account. If you have never registered for programming before, please visit your local parks and recreation center to setup your household. Please make sure to bring proof of residency.

#### **HOW do I register?**

**Camp Registration Forms** - Registration forms are available at each of the community camp centers. Please fill out the registration form completely including emergency phone numbers, pick-up contacts and medical or behavioral conditions.

**Residency - Proof of residency is required at the time of registration.** Acceptable documents include residential water bill, voter registration card, FP&L bill or Lease agreement or property tax bill.

**Camp Fees** - All camp fees are due and payable at the time of registration. **Payment method must be Visa or MasterCard only.**

#### **Do we qualify for a scholarship?**

The Youth Enrichment Scholarship (Y.E.S.) is available to City residents. Applicants must bring proof that the child is currently on the School Board's reduced or free lunch program and proof of City residency.
