

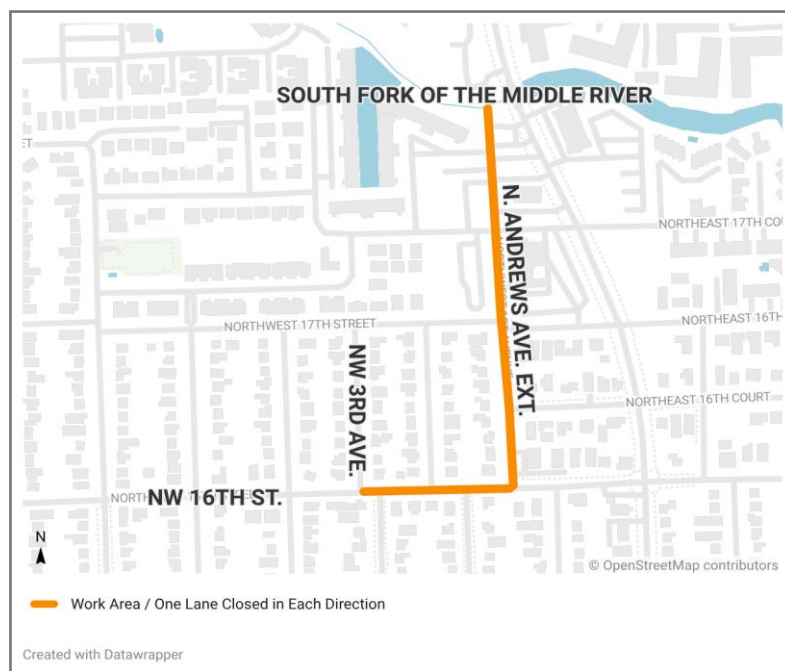


STORMWATER PIPE CLEANING & INSPECTIONS IN SOUTH MIDDLE RIVER

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with FloTech Environmental to clean and inspect stormwater pipes in South Middle River along:

- N. Andrews Avenue Extension from NW 16th Street to the South Fork of the Middle River
- NW 16th Street from NW 3rd Avenue to N. Andrews Avenue Extension

Work began in July 2026 and is taking place on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Completion is expected in August 2026. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.



What to Expect

- Crews are accessing stormwater pipes through manholes to clean them and record videos within the pipes to document their condition.
- The roadway is not being disturbed and minimal noise is expected.

Traffic Impacts

- One lane along the streets listed above may be closed daily during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel are directing traffic as needed.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
