Sunrise Boulevard Bridge Over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) Traffic Shift: Sept. 3 through Early 2027

Beginning Thursday, Sept. 3, at 8 a.m., the Sunrise Boulevard south bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) will be closed. Eastbound and Westbound traffic will be shifted to the north bridge, maintaining two lanes in each direction.

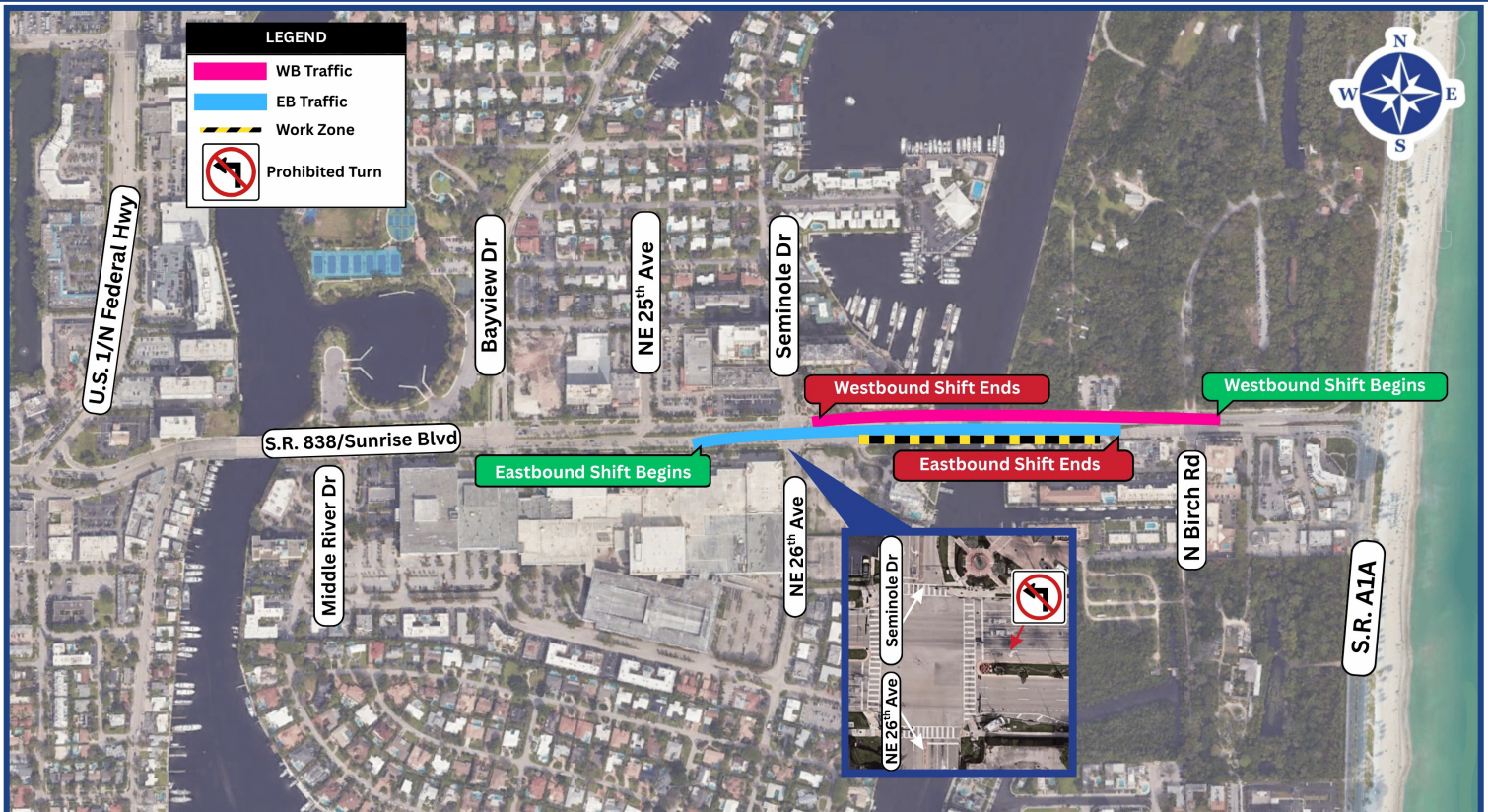
During this traffic configuration, left turns from westbound Sunrise Boulevard to southbound NE 26th Avenue will be prohibited. This traffic pattern will remain in place through early 2027.

No drawbridge openings will occur during a 48-hour period starting 8 a.m. Tuesday, Sept. 1, to 8 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 3, 2026. The temporary change to the drawbridge operating schedule has been coordinated with the U.S. Coast Guard, and details will be published in the Local Notice to Mariners.
