The following is a synopsis of the significant motions made at the Marine Advisory Board meeting of May 3, 2018, (minutes attached) that were specifically adopted as recommendations to the City Commission:

VIII. Presentation – South Fork Marina / 1500 SW 17th Street

Motion made by Mr. Strobel, seconded by Vice Chair Henderson, to eliminate condition #1, which limited the number of slips to 26, from the list of 14 conditions previously required by the MAB

In a voice vote, the **motion** passed unanimously.

IX. Dock Permit – Olas Capital LLC & James D. Wilson / 341 Idlewild Drive & 333 Poinciana Drive (REVISED)

Motion made by Mr. Strobel, seconded by Mr. Berry, to accept as is, with the restrictions that the first two boats are limited to 35 ft. and the third boat is limited to 25 ft.

In a roll call vote, the **motion** passed 8-2 (Chair Guardabassi and Ms. Engle dissenting). (Mr. Batchelor was not present for the vote.)
