DISTRICT ONE - COMMISSIONER HEATHER MORAITIS



- On September 2nd, an individual responsible for multiple thefts was arrested while committing a theft in another jurisdiction. FLPD detectives had identified him from multiple previous incidents in the City of Fort Lauderdale and had issued two arrest warrants. This individual was later charged with thefts from Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties.

- On August 30th, several vehicle burglaries occurred over the month of August on Fort Lauderdale Beach. DISTRICT FOUR – COMMISSIONER BEN SORENSON



- On September 4th, officers responded to 110 Southeast 22nd Street where a victim was located suffering from a gun shot wound. Moments later, another gun shot victim was located nearby. Both victims were transported to BHMC but were not cooperative with our investigation. It was quickly determined the two incidents were related and there was no further public safety threat to the public. News release:

- On September 5th, FLPD began investigating a sexual battery that occurred at 208 Southeast 12th Street (Angel Day Spa). Preliminary information is a male suspect entered the business, exposed himself and then began to attack the victim. The information on a video was disseminated in hopes of generating leads. Broward County Crime Stoppers issued a flyer which was printed and disseminated in the area by FLPD's NAT team officers.
