The Purchase Assistance Program assists eligible first-time homebuyers with a 15 year deferred payment loan to be applied towards down payment, closing cost and/or principal reduction for the purchase of eligible housing within the City of Fort Lauderdale limits.

This program includes single family homes, townhouses, condominiums or villas. Both existing and newly constructed homes are eligible.

Mobile Homes and Manufactured Housing are not eligible.

FIRST-TIME HOME BUYER CRITERIA

- ✓ Individual(s) who has had no ownership in a principal residence during the 3-year period ending on the date of purchase of the property,
- ✓ A spouse (if either meets the above requirements, they are considered first-time homebuyers),
- ✓ Single parent who has only owned with a spouse while married,
- ✓ Individual(s) who is a displaced homemaker and has only owned with a spouse,
- ✓ Individual(s) who has only owned a principal residence not permanently affixed to a permanent foundation in accordance with the applicable regulations; or
- ✓ Individual(s) who has only owned property that was not in compliance with State, local, or model building codes and which cannot be brought into compliance for less than the cost of constructing a permanent structure.

INCOME CATEGORIES TO BE SERVED

The program is designed to assist very low-, low- and moderate-income households as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and adopted by the State of Florida and distributed by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation for use in the SHIP Program
